

MODBURY HOSPITAL PAEDIATRICS

If elected in March 2014, a Marshall Liberal Government will ensure the paediatric ward remains at Modbury Hospital with associated paediatric services.

The Weatherill Labor Government has recently announced plans to close the paediatric ward.

The Liberal Party understands that the closure of the paediatric ward would be a severe blow to families in the north-eastern suburbs, many of whom rely on the ward for the health of their children.

Under Labor's plan, sick or injured children who are assessed as needing admission to a hospital will need to wait on average for three hours for an ambulance to transport them to the Lyell McEwin Hospital.

South Australians deserve a Government with the right priorities to get our state back on track – and one of those priorities is to ensure a paediatric ward with associated paediatric services at Modbury Hospital remains open.

“As a father, I understand just how important it is for parents to have quick and close access to the health services their children need,” said State Liberal Leader Steven Marshall.

“Jay Weatherill's policy of closing the ward makes no sense and we will strongly oppose it.”

“The State Liberal team has listened and responded to the community's concerns. We will not close the Modbury Hospital paediatric ward.”
