Positive signs for Gifford Hill development

There are positive signs for the stalled Murray Bridge Racing Club Gifford Hill development.

In a meeting with the new Minister responsible for regional South Australia Geoff Brock on Monday, Liberal Member for Hammond, Adrian Pederick, raised the Murray Bridge Racing Club Gifford Hill development.

“I’m very pleased that Minister Brock made the commitment to spend a whole day in Hammond to explore this exciting project and also committed to meeting with the Murray Bridge Racing Club,” said Mr Pederick.

“I am hopeful that Mr Brock will discuss potential funding options with the Weatherill Labor Government to reignite the stalled project.
