Federal funding for Hammond

State Liberal Member for Hammond, Adrian Pederick, has today welcomed the announcement of \$12.5 million of Federal Government funding for the Murraylands.

\$7.5 million is funding the development for the SA Motorsport Park just outside Tailem Bend.

“This project will be a real boom for Tailem Bend, Murray Bridge and all surrounding districts. The Peregrine Group have the vision and are keen to connect motorsport activities with other ventures in the region,” said Mr Pederick.

“I am excited for the opportunities and possibilities this development will bring, such as potentially holding a Clipsal event at the SA Motorsport Park.

A further \$5 million announced today will go towards the Gifford Hill Development.
