



## Hopes for 'The Shed' to reopen

GOOLWA - A committee has been formed in a bid for an entertainment venue for teenagers in Goolwa to reopen.

'The Shed', located at 4 Dowdodd Street was closed in early August prior to a music event being held, as Alexandrina Council said the property was approved only for industrial purposes. The Shed had been used for the Investigator College formal after party and birthdays.

Community members, business people, Alexandrina councillors and member for Hammond, Adrian Pederick, met at the venue on Thursday, October 2, to discuss the next step in a potential bid to have The Shed reopened.

A committee comprising 20 people was formed, with the group's priority to secure grants totalling \$50,000 to ensure the building complies with the building code.

The property owner, Chris Stewart, said he hopes local musicians will play at the facility and teenagers will continue to hold their parties there. A Facebook group 'Save the Shed - Goolwa' has been set up, and another meeting has been arranged at The Shed for Thursday, October 16, at 5.30pm - 6.30pm. The community is encouraged to attend.
