



Wellington Weir Debate on Again!

Iconic Victorian winemaker Darren De Bortoli has joined with environmentalist, Ken Jury to reignite the River Murray-Darling debate.

The Victorian based winemaker and Goolwa based investigative journalist both believe an additional lock is necessary to save billions of litres of Murray Darling Basin water each year.

The proposed Lock Zero could be built above Wellington. Both say this would provide a welcome reprieve from the ongoing 'Us-versus-Them' debate between irrigators, conser-

vationists and government.

The fresh call for a lock or weir at Wellington on the Murray does not impress Hammond MP Adrian Pederick however.

Mr Pederick says he fought against the construction of a lock or weir above Wellington when it was first announced in 2006-07 and his view has not changed claiming it is just madness.
