Aquatics and music petitions object to budget cuts

Local Member of Parliament Adrian Pederick is assisting local organisations to voice their objection to threatened cuts in school aquatics and music programs.

In response to recent announcements of budget cuts affecting aquatics and music programs in South Australian schools, community groups and individuals affected have raised petitions to ask the Minister for Education to reverse the decisions.

Residents who wish to voice their opposition to the changes are invited to add their names to the petitions which are circulating in the community and around the state. The petitions will be gathered up on Monday November 20 to be presented to Parliament during the next sitting.
