Communities should enquire about grants says local MP

Community groups involved in sport, recreation and multi-cultural activities are among many who can apply for various grants currently available from the State Government.

State MP Adrian Pederick, Member for Hammond, is urging not-for-profit community groups to consider their eligibility for some of the funding currently available.

Multi-cultural grants vary from very small amounts up to \$20,000 and are aimed at promoting awareness and celebrating the diversity of South Australian ethnic cultures.

Grants may support projects, events, festivals and one-off community development initiatives, particularly in rural and regional South Australia.

Meanwhile, the Office of Recreation and Sport has released guidelines for the 2007-08 Community Recreation and Sport Facilities Program, which can provide grants of between \$20,000 and \$300,000 to develop facilities that contribute to the social, physical and economic benefits of participation in recreation and sport activities.

Mr Pederick said the programs were just two of the many grants currently available and encouraged all bona fide not-for-profit community groups to enquire about the range and eligibility requirements.
