Grant aids Town Hall redevelopment study

A state government grant to the Rural City of Murray Bridge will help them conduct a feasibility study into the redevelopment of the Murray Bridge Town Hall, the only significant facility of its kind in the district.

Local MP and Member for Hammond Adrian Pederick presented Mayor Allan Arbon with the \$11,000 cheque, made available through the Cultural Facilities Program managed by Arts SA.

Built almost a century ago and located in the centre of the main business district, the Town Hall provides a prominent historical link with the city's heritage and its importance as a centre for agriculture and rail transport and as a major riverport, serving many generations as a focal point for community gatherings and civic activities.

The grant will assist with the preparation of a feasibility study to research the building's potential in concept, design and business plan. Community consultation will be part of that study.
