Clayton CFS to get fire hydrant at station

Local MP, Member for Hammond Adrian Pederick says that as part of a project to supply mains water to Clayton, SA Water have offered to provide the town's CFS station with a fire hydrant.

At a meeting of the Public Works Committee last Wednesday, attended by Mr Pederick, SA Water's Head of Planning and Infrastructure Roger Perry said they would provide the local CFS with a hydrant.

The Committee has been discussing the detail of the proposed extension of the existing mains water supply from nearby Milang to the Clayton Bay Estate development, which is planned to be completed by the end of 2007.

Mr Pederick presented a submission to the committee on behalf of the Clayton Community Association and a series of questions posed by the submission were asked through fellow MPs, committee members David Pisoni and Michael Pengilly.

In response to the question about a fire hydrant, Mr Perry replied, 'If they want a hydrant, we'll give them a hydrant, that's OK.'

Also at the meeting, SA Water's Project Manager Mr Tim Kilgariff said that consideration was being given by SA Water and Alexandrina Council to providing an alternative water source to Clayton residents not currently connected to SA Water infrastructure.

'Consultation with the local community and landholders will commence in July 2007 to ensure that the project produces satisfactory outcomes for all Clayton residents,' Mr Kilgariff said.
